



## Dan Reis Memorial Scholarship



In support of the essential work that keeps our communities thriving, the Dan Reis Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to a student pursuing a degree or training in education, agriculture, or the skilled trades. This scholarship reflects a commitment to investing in future professionals dedicated to service, innovation, and community impact.

Dan Reis was a lifelong farmer and hunter and a strong educator in the fields of conservation and skilled trades. Dan worked tirelessly to bring knowledge to his students and community by serving on multiple county, township, and organizational boards and by helping to start and lead the state-recognized School-to-Work program. Dan Reis served for 10 years on the Board of

Directors for Pierce Pepin Cooperative Services (PPCS).

The Dan Reis Memorial Scholarship will be offered to students meeting the following criteria:

- Graduating high school senior or currently enrolled college student.
- Must be attending or planning to attend the University of Wisconsin – River Falls or Chippewa Valley Technical College.
- Must be pursuing a degree in Education, Agriculture, or Skilled Trades (e.g., electrician, welder, plumber, HVAC, lineman, carpenter).
- Must be an active PPCS member or the child/legal dependent of an active PPCS member residing in the same household.
