Pierce Pepin Cooperative Services (PPCS) must construct and maintain its electrical distribution facilities at times. This includes, but is not limited to, work to construct, reconstruct, rephrase, operate, repair, inspect, maintain, relocate, and replace poles, cable, wire, grounds, and other attachments, equipment, accessories, and appurtenances necessary and appropriate for the distribution of electric energy to the property owner's premises and/or Cooperative members on, over and under the surface of the earth. In addition, all Cooperative Members lines, meters, equipment, and property entrances must always be kept accessible to the Cooperative. PPCS wants to work with you to avoid unnecessary damage.

The Undersigned owner of the property identified above hereby acknowledges and authorizes work by the Cooperative on his/her property for the purpose of constructing and maintaining electrical facilities. The undersigned property owner represents and acknowledges there are no underground facilities (i.e. septic, well, fiber internet, gas, water, power lines, phone lines, facilities for future out buildings, replacement septic, areas, invisible dog fences, etc.) in place on the property identified above that can be damaged by excavation (*except those that have been located and clearly identified with visible warning markers*).

Furthermore, the property owner recognizes the potential hazard of oak wilt during the period of April 15th through July 1st and shall not hold the cooperative liable for any oak wilt damage arising through cable plowing or line installation during this time. (See DNR pub. PUB-FR-127 97)

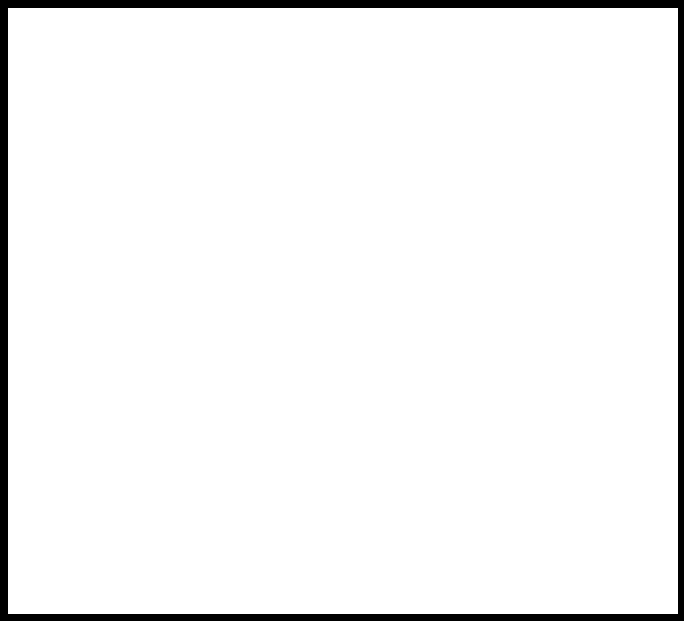
